- придавать, наделять  
 the furnishings imparted an air of elegance to the room - обстановка делала комнату изящной  
 exercise imparts vigour to the body - от (физических) упражнений тело становится сильным  
 the smoke imparted its odour to his clothes - его одежда пропахла дымом
- делиться (*мыслями, чувствами и т. п.*); сообщать, передавать  
 I have nothing of interest to impart to you - не могу сообщить вам ничего интересного  
 to impart one's apprehensions - высказать свои опасения  
 to impart one's happiness [troubles, sorrows] - поделиться своей радостью [своими неприятностями огорчениями]  
 to impart one's knowledge [one's skill] - поделиться своими знаниями [своим умением]  
 to impart news - сообщить новости  
 to impart one's warmth to smb. - согреть кого-л. своим теплом
