one of the two front parts of the top of a coat or jacket that are joined to the [↑]collar and are folded back

- to wear a flower in your lapel
- He grabbed him by the lapels of his jacket.

Word Origin:

mid 17th cent.: diminutive of the noun [↑]lap sense 1.

Example Bank:

- A silver brooch was pinned to her lapel.
- He grabbed her by the lapels and shook her violently.
- He was wearing a carnation in his lapel.
- a coat with wide lapels
- a jacket with a badge on the lapel
