Word Origin:late 16th cent.: from Latin **ejaculat-** ‘darted out’, from the verb **ejaculari**, from **e-** (variant of **ex-**) ‘out’ + **jaculari** ‘to dart’ (from **jaculum** ‘dart, javelin’, from **jacere** ‘to throw’).**ejaculate**
