- **environmental issues** Environmental issues, such as cliff erosion and pollution, directly affect people's lives.
- **environmental protection** Is environmental protection more important than economic growth?
- **environmental damage** the environmental damage caused by opencast mining
- **environmental pollution** Power stations cause a lot of environmental pollution.
- **environmental problems** Acid rain is one of the major environmental problems associated with burning coal.
- **environmental concerns** Residents have raised some valid environmental concerns about the nuclear plant.
- **environmental awareness** (=how aware people are of environmental issues) Schools are crucial in helping to raise environmental awareness.
- **an environmental group** a campaign by environmental groups to protect the Antarctic
- **the environmental movement** (=all the groups concerned about the environment) There are differences of opinion about nuclear power within the environmental movement.
