Word Origin:

[**taxation**] Middle English (in the sense 'the assessment of a penalty or damages'): via Old French from Latin *taxatio(n-)*, from *taxare* 'to censure, charge'.

Example Bank:

- Any profits made are totally exempt from taxation.
- If the government raises direct taxation, it will lose votes.
- The charge was seen as just another form of taxation.
- The hospital was funded from taxation.
- The loss before taxation was \$2.7 million.
- The party's policy is to reduce the burden of taxation on the poor.
- The poll tax was a very unpopular form of taxation.
- They were treated as a married couple for taxation purposes.
- a promise to lower the overall level of taxation
- changes in corporate taxation
- increased taxation on oil companies
- reducing the heavy burden of taxation on the wealthy
- the heavy taxation on smokers and drinkers
- the inability to levy sufficient taxation to meet the costs of government
- the power to raise funds through taxation
- the proposal to eliminate the double taxation of dividends
