- the greatest feat of today - величайший подвиг наших дней
- today's youth - нынешняя молодёжь
- ◇ one today is worth two tomorrows - *посл.* ≅ лучше синица в руках, чем журавль в небе

- a week ago today - восемь дней тому назад
- he's here today and gone tomorrow - сегодня /нынче/ он здесь, а завтра - там

2) в настоящее время, в наши дни

- this is no problem today - в наши дни это не проблема
