Example Bank:

- Ensure that your site is updated to the latest version of the software.
- The files are continuously updated with new information.
- The official site is updated on a regular basis.
- The program automatically updates your antivirus settings.
- The road map has been fully updated.
- They have just recently updated their server software.
- updating all the files manually

noun *BrE* [ˈʌpdeɪt] ^u; *NAmE* [ˈʌpdeɪt] ^u

1. ~ **(on sth)** a report or broadcast that gives the most recent information about sth; a new version of sth containing the most recent information
• a news update
2. (*computing*) the most recent improvements to a computer program that are sent to users of the program

Example Bank:

- Google had to release an update for the toolbar.
- Here's a quick update on the travel situation.
- I added your name to my update list.
- I get regular updates by email.
- In Windows you can set up automatic updates.
- The 6 o'clock news provides the latest updates.
- The report gives an update on the currency crisis.
- We need an update to the mailing list.
- We'll have a live update on the storm's progress from the experts.
- You have to download the update and save it to your hard drive
- an update on the political crisis

1. to add the most recent information to something:
The files need updating.
2. to make something more modern in the way it looks or operates:
plans to update manufacturing procedures
3. *spoken* to tell someone the most recent information about a situation
update somebody on something
Can you update me on what's been happening?
