the alleged refusal [acceptance] - якобы полученный отказ [-ое согласие]

the alleged murderer - лицо, обвиняемое в убийстве; предполагаемый убийца

alleged crime - *юр.* вменяемое в вину /инкриминированное/ преступление

alleged miracle - так называемое /мнимое/ чудо
