- 1. a copy of a book, piece of music, etc. before it has been printed
- an unpublished/original manuscript
- I read her poems in manuscript .
- 2. a very old book or document that was written by hand before printing was invented
  - medieval illuminated manuscripts

### Word Origin:

late 16th cent.: from medieval Latin manuscriptus, from manu 'by hand' + scriptus 'written' (past participle of scribere).
