- 1. **uncountable** large, heavy guns which are often moved on wheels
 - The town is under heavy artillery fire.
 - **artillery attacks/barrages/shells**
- 2. **the artillery** **singular** the section of an army trained to use these guns
 - He was a captain in the Royal Artillery.

Word Origin:

late Middle English: from Old French **artillerie**, from **artiller**, alteration of **atillier** 'equip, arm', probably a variant of **atirer**, from **a-** (from Latin **ad** 'to, at') + **tire** 'rank, order'.

Example Bank:

- The soldiers of the artillery train had panicked and cut the traces of their horses.

- A stray artillery shell struck the hospital.
- The army launched a heavy artillery barrage against enemy positions.
