1. the wine that was produced in a particular year or place; the year in which it was produced
 - the 1999 vintage
 - 2005 was a particularly fine vintage.
2. **usually singular** the period or season of gathering [↑]grapes for making wine
 - The vintage was later than usual.

Word Origin:

late Middle English: alteration (influenced by [↑]vintner) of earlier vendage, from Old French **vendange** from Latin **vindemia** (from **vinum** 'wine' + **demere** 'remove').

Example Bank:

- the youngest vintages of wines

adjective only before noun

1. vintage wine is of very good quality and has been stored for several years
 2. (*BrE*) (*of a vehicle*) made between 1919 and 1930 and admired for its style and interest
 - a vintage rally (= for vehicles of this type)
- compare** [↑]veteran car
3. typical of a period in the past and of high quality; the best work of the particular person
 - a collection of vintage designs
 - vintage TV drama
 - The opera is vintage Rossini.
 4. **~ year** a particularly good and successful year
 - 2008 was not a vintage year for the movies.

 - " There are some classic songs on the album, but most are of more recent vintage.
