2. (*computing*) a series of letters or numbers that you must type into a computer or computer system in order to be able to use it
  - Enter a username and password to get into the system.

Example Bank:

- You must give the password before they'll let you in.
- Your mailbox can be password protected to ensure security.
- a software tool developed by hackers to crack passwords
