1. **uncountable, countable ~ (of sth)** the use of legal authority to take sth from sb; an amount of sth that is taken in this way
  - The court ordered the seizure of his assets.
  - the largest ever seizure of cocaine at a British port
2. **uncountable ~ (of sth)** the act of using force to take control of a country, town, etc
  - the army's seizure of power
  - the seizure of Burma by Japan in 1942
3. (old-fashioned) **countable** a sudden attack of an illness, especially one that affects the brain
  - an epileptic seizure

- The Act confers powers of entry, search and seizure on the police.
- It was the largest ever seizure of cocaine at a British port.
- The invasion began with the seizure of the country's largest southern city.
- The military took control of the country in an illegal seizure of power.
