- 1. intransitive, transitive** to become or make sth warmer, especially food, so that it is no longer frozen
 - It will take about four hours to defrost.
 - ~ **sth** Make sure you defrost the chicken completely before cooking.
- 2. transitive, intransitive** ~ (**sth**) when you defrost a fridge/refrigerator or ↑freezer, or when it defrosts, you remove the ice from it
 compare ↑de-ice, ↑melt, ↑thaw, ↑unfreeze
- 3. transitive** ~ **sth** (NAmE) to remove ice from the surface of a car's windows

1. [intransitive and transitive] if frozen food defrosts, or if you defrost it, it gets warmer until it is not frozen ⇔ **melt, thaw**
2. [intransitive and transitive] if a ↑freezer or ↑refrigerator defrosts, or if you defrost it, it is turned off so that the ice inside it melts
3. [transitive] *American English* to remove ice from inside the windows of a car by using heat or warm air
