 - Tsar Nicholas II
 - (in compounds) (*informal*) an official whose job is to advise the government on policy in a particular area: (*BrE*) a drugs tsar
 - (*NAmE*) a drug tsar

Word Origin:from Russian **tsar'**, representing Latin **Caesar**.Example Bank:

- On 15th March 1917, the Tsar abdicated.
- The fort was established in 1632 by the ruling tsar.
- The table was a gift to Tsar Nicholas from Queen Victoria.
