- settle a lawsuit (=to reach an agreement that stops a lawsuit) I would prefer to settle the lawsuit out of court.
- drop a lawsuit (=to stop taking a lawsuit to court) First Bank agreed to drop its lawsuits against another bank as a result of the decision.
- win/lose a lawsuit She won a discrimination lawsuit against her former company.
