Maker, manufacturer or producer? **Maker** and **manufacturer** are used especially about goods such as cars that are put together from different parts; **producer** is used more about natural materials such as oil that are grown or obtained and then processed. **Maker** is also used about products for which quality and skill are seen to be important, such as steel and wine.

- maker** a company or person whose business is to make things to be sold, either by hand or using machines: the country's largest car maker | We got a cabinet maker (=someone who makes furniture from wood) to redo our kitchen for us.
- producer** a company or country that makes large quantities of something to be sold - often used about raw materials such as oil, coffee, or steel: OPEC is an organization of 13 major oil producers. | Gold producers' shares went up by 50%.
- manufacturer** a company that makes things in large quantities, especially in a factory: Clothing manufacturers have been

feeling the effects of the recession. | a plane manufacturer

▪ **shipbuilder/boatbuilder** a person or company that makes ships or boats: a Japanese shipbuilder, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries | He started out as a boatbuilder.
