4. **uncountable, countable** ~ (with sb/sth) a strong feeling of sympathy, understanding or support for sb/sth
  - her emotional identification with the play's heroine

5. **uncountable, countable** ~ (of sb) (with sb/sth) the process of making a close connection between one person or thing and another
  - the voters' identification of the Democrats with high taxes

Word Origin:mid 17th cent.: originally from medieval Latin **identificat-** 'identified', from the verb **identificare**; later from **↑identify**.Example Bank:
