a match/game, or a series of them, between two players or teams with equal points or scores to decide who the winner is

- They lost to Chicago in the play-offs.

Example Bank:

- He won a sudden-death play-off.
- The team have reached the play-offs.

'play-off *BrE* " *AmE* " *noun* [countable]

1. *British English* a game played to decide who will win after a previous game has ended with two teams or players having equal points
2. [usually plural] *American English* a game, usually one of a series of games, played by the best teams or players in a competition in order to decide the final winner:
 - The Lakers will meet the Bulls in the playoffs.
