 - a **monthly meeting /visit/magazine**
2. paid, valid or calculated for one month
 - a monthly salary of £1 000
 - a monthly season ticket
 - Summers are hot, with monthly averages above 22°C.

adverb

every month or once a month

- She gets paid monthly.

noun (pl. **month-lies**)

a magazine published once a month

- the fashion monthlies

1. happening once a month:
 - The mortgage is payable in monthly instalments.
 - a monthly publication
2. used to talk about the total amount of something that is received, paid, measured, or calculated in a month:
 - a monthly salary of \$850
 - a monthly rainfall of four inches
3. a monthly ticket, ↑pass etc can be used for a period of one month

—**monthly** adverb:

- They meet monthly to discuss progress.
