1. ~ (in sth) having none or not enough of sth
 - She's not usually lacking in confidence.
 - The book is completely lacking in originality.
 - He was taken on as a teacher but was **found lacking** (= was thought not to be good enough) .
2. not present or not available

Syn: ↑missing

- I feel there is something lacking in my life.

Example Bank:

- Her remarks were curiously lacking in perception.
- The book is altogether lacking in originality.
- Tom was conspicuously lacking in enthusiasm for the idea.
- an area of policy where the government has been found seriously lacking
- the passion sadly lacking from his performance
- He was taken on as a teacher but was found lacking.
- She's not usually lacking in confidence.
