accomplishment of desires - исполнение желаний  
difficult of accomplishment - трудновыполнимый
2. **достижение**  
accomplishments of scientists - открытия учёных; достижения науки  
the teacher was proud of her pupil's accomplishments - учительница гордилась успехами своих учеников
3. **обыкн. pl**
  - 1) **достоинства, совершенства**  
a man of many accomplishments - человек, обладающий многими достоинствами  
in spite of all her accomplishments - несмотря на все её достоинства  
good marksmanship is usually a manly accomplishment - меткими стрелками обычно бывают мужчины
  - 2) **арх.** достоинства благовоспитанной девицы; умение играть на фортепиано рисовать, танцевать *и т. п.*
