['mænjuskript] ^u **noun** (abbr. MS)

- a copy of a book, piece of music, etc. before it has been printed
 - an **unpublished/original manuscript**
 - I read her poems **in manuscript** .
- a very old book or document that was written by hand before printing was invented
 - medieval illuminated manuscripts

Word Origin:

late 16th cent.: from medieval Latin **manuscriptus**, from **manu** 'by hand' + **scriptus** 'written' (past participle of **scribere**).

Example Bank:

- He submitted the manuscript to an editor at Longman.
- He was delighted when the manuscript was accepted for publication.
- Her autobiography remained in manuscript.
- I only have one copy of the manuscript.
- One contemporary manuscript shows Henry II crowned by the hand of Christ.
- The text ran to dozens of pages in manuscript form.
- earlier manuscripts which no longer survive
- the original autograph manuscript of the poem
- the surviving manuscript of 'Beowulf'
- I read her plays in manuscript.
- an unpublished manuscript
