- (disapproving)** a situation in which sb treats sb else in an unfair way, especially in order to make money from their work
 - the exploitation of children
 - Starvation and poverty are the result of global economic exploitation, not lack of resources.
- the use of land, oil, minerals, etc
 - commercial exploitation of the mineral resources in Antarctica
- (disapproving)** the fact of using a situation in order to get an advantage for yourself
 - exploitation of the situation for his own purposes

- The party's avowed aim was to struggle against capitalist exploitation.
- Turtles are increasingly threatened by human exploitation.
