Syn: ↑recompense
 - ~ **sb (for sth)** How can I ever repay you for your generosity?
 - ~ **sth (with sth)** Their trust was repaid with fierce loyalty.
3. ~ **sth** (*BrE, formal*) if sth repays your attention, interest, study, etc, it is worth spending time to look at it, etc
 - The report repays careful reading.

- The loan must be repaid in full by December 31.
- The proceeds from the sale will be used to repay the loan.
- This money must be repaid to the bank.

- I'll repay you for the ticket next week.
- When are you going to repay your brother?
