1. a small book of plain paper for writing notes in
 - The police officer wrote the details down in his notebook.
2. (*NAmE*) (*BrE* **'exercise book'**) a small book for students to write their work in



3. (*also* **notebook com'puter**) a small computer that can work with a battery and be easily carried
