COLLOCATIONS**adjectives**

- **sudden** Consult the doctor if there is a very sudden onset of fever.
- **abrupt** the abrupt onset of the rainy season in India (=happening very quickly and suddenly)
- **rapid** Symptoms may include the rapid onset of nausea and vomiting.
- **early/late onset** (=happening earlier or later than commonly happens – used especially about serious illnesses) The patient had a family history of early onset Alzheimer's disease.

verbs

- **delay the onset of something** An active and healthy lifestyle can delay the onset of disease in later life.
- **mark the onset of something** The tradition originates from an old Celtic feast marking the onset of winter.
