I. Yank BrE *"* AmE *"* (also **Yankee) *noun [countable]* British English informal**

[Date: 1700-1800; Origin: Yankee]

an American – often used to show disapproval

II. Yankee /'jæŋki/ BrE *"* AmE *"* *noun [countable]* informal

[Date: 1700-1800; Origin: Perhaps from Dutch Jantje 'Johnny', used as a word for Dutch people who came to America in the 18th century]

1. a soldier who fought on the side of the Union (=the northern states) during the American Civil War

2. **American English** someone born in or living in the northern states of the US – sometimes used in an insulting way by people from the southern US3. **British English** an American – often used to show disapproval **SYN Yank**4. **American English** someone from New England**Yankee**

- 1) often **derogatory** a person who lives in, or is from, the US
- 2) an inhabitant of New England or one of the northern states
- **historical** a Union soldier in the Civil War
- 3) a code word representing the letter Y, used in radio communication
- 4) (**also Yankee jib (Yan·kee jib)**) **Sailing** a large jib set forward of a staysail in light winds
- 5) a bet on four or more horses to win (or be placed) in different races **informal**

Origin:mid 18th cent.: origin uncertain; recorded in the late 17th cent. as a nickname; perhaps from Dutch *Janke*, diminutive of *Jan* 'John.'**yankee**
