COLLOCATIONS■ **adjectives**

- good** Your eyesight must be very good if you can read the sign from here.
- keen** (=extremely good) Eagles are known for their extremely keen eyesight.
- perfect** She's in her seventies, but her eyesight is still perfect.
- bad/poor** Moles have very poor eyesight.
- failing** In his later years, he suffered from failing eyesight.

■ **verbs**

- somebody's eyesight fails** He's over 80 now, and his eyesight is beginning to fail.
- somebody's eyesight gets worse/deteriorates** Your eyesight gradually deteriorates with age.

■ **eyesight + NOUN**

- eyesight problems** Her eyesight problems ruled out a job as a pilot.
- an eyesight examination /test** The cost of the eyesight examination may be refunded.
