Cel·sius /'selsiəs/ *BrE* *AmE* *noun* [uncountable] (written abbreviation **C**)

[Date: 1800-1900; Origin: Anders Celsius (1701-44), Swedish scientist who invented the scale]

a scale of temperature in which water freezes at 0° and boils at 100° **SYN Centigrade** ⇒ **Fahrenheit**:

12° Celsius (=12 degrees on the Celsius scale)

—**Celsius** *adjective***Celsius**

OxfordAmericanDictionary (En-En)

1. **Cel·si·us** (abbr.: C)*adj.* of or denoting a scale of temperature on which water freezes at 0° and boils at 100° under standard conditions [*postpositive when used with a numeral*]2. **Cel·si·us***n.* this scale of temperature (*also Celsius scale*)

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Usage:Celsius, rather than **centigrade**, is the standard accepted term when giving temperatures: use

25° Celsius

rather than

25° centigrade
