[ˈriːs(ə)ntli] *adv*

недавно; на днях; в последнее время

as recently as yesterday - ещё только вчера

as recently as last month - только в прошлом месяце

until quite recently - до самого последнего времени

as recently as a quarter of a century ago - всего какую-нибудь четверть века назад

I did not hear it until just recently - я только недавно об этом услышал

they are recently married - они недавно /только что/ поженились

not long ago

- We received a letter from him recently.
- Until recently they were living in York.
- I haven't seen them recently (= it is some time since I saw them) .
- Have you used it recently (= in the recent past) ?

- I haven't seen them recently.
- Until recently they were living in New York.

not long ago:

- He has recently been promoted to Assistant Manager.
- a recently published biography
- Jerry lived in Cairo until quite recently.
- More recently, he's appeared in a number of British films.

THESAURUS

- **recently** not long ago, especially a few days, weeks, or months ago: The President has recently returned from a tour of South America. | A new species of plant was recently discovered in Brazil.
- **lately** *especially spoken* during the recent past, especially during the weeks or days closest to now: I've been really busy lately so I haven't been out much. | There hasn't been much in the news lately.
- **just** *especially spoken* a very short time ago, especially only a few minutes, hours, days, or weeks ago: John's just gone out. | They've just had a new baby.
- **a short/little while ago** *especially spoken* not long ago – often used when you are not sure exactly when: That house was sold a short while ago. | I looked in on her a little while ago and she was fast asleep.
- **the other day** *spoken* recently, especially only a few days ago: I met Lucy in town the other day. | You'll never guess what happened to me the other day.
- **freshly** made, prepared, done etc not long ago – used especially about food and drink. Also used about things that have just been painted, washed, or dug: freshly baked bread | freshly squeezed orange juice | The boat had been freshly painted.
- **newly** created, built, married etc not long ago: the newly created position of Chief Designer | a newly married couple | their newly elected president
