[**suet**] Middle English: from Anglo-Norman French, from the synonymous word **su**, from Latin **sebum** 'tallow'.

Example Bank:

- Christmas pudding is just one example of a traditional suet pudding.
- Mincemeat often contains raw suet, so make sure you store it in the fridge.
