Word Origin:

early 19th cent. (originally of a person): probably the second element of **mumbo-jumbo**. Originally denoting a large and clumsy person, the term became popular as the name of an elephant at London Zoo, which was sold in 1882 to the Barnum and Bailey circus.

adjective only before noun (informal)

very large; larger than usual

- a jumbo pack of cornflakes
