pass a message on to somebody (also pass it on informal) to tell another person the information that has been told to you: She's with a client at the moment, but I'll pass the message on to her. I If I get any news, I'll pass it on.

- brief to give someone all the necessary information about a situation, so that they can do their work: Police officers were briefed

before going out to arrest the suspects.
